

# 6 Hour Cascais Rollers

## September 9<sup>th</sup> | 10:30 am

### **The Event**

The 6 Hour Cascais Rollers is a competition organized by McLerige, in association with the Portuguese Skating Federation, and is part of the sixth edition of the Corrida Jumbo.

It takes place on September 9<sup>th</sup> at the Autódromo do Estoril, and it's a 6-hour endurance skating competition, open to individual participants and teams of 2 to 5 skaters in a relay system, to make the longer distance in 6 hours, skating.

The competition is open to any participant, licensed or not, from any nationality, born until 2005.

The participation of minors (13 to 17 years old) is allowed and presupposes the presentation of the Term of Responsibility (available on the Portuguese version) for authorization by the legal guardian of the minor, when collecting the participation kit.

Those who enter the 6 Hour Cascais Rollers can participate in the Speed Skating Race that takes place on September 8<sup>th</sup>, at 4:00 pm, at the Estoril racetrack, in order to recognize the track, and must use one of the bibs that will be delivered to them in the starting kit, being entitled to the prizes for the licensed athletes (two laps on the track) in the speed test.

### **Categories**

- Category SOLO
- Category DUO (two people)
- Category TEAM (3 to 5 people)
- Category QUADS (3 to 5 people)
- Category SKATE LONGBOARD (3 to 5 people)
- Category JOVEM (3 to 5 people, one must be adult)

Disabled participants can join any team.

All teams can be mixed and composed of licensed athletes or not.

The categories "SOLO" and "DUO" are open only to adults.

In the QUADS teams all their members must always skate with quads (traditional skates).

In the SKATE LONGBOARD teams all their members must always skate with skateboards.

### **MATERIAL AUTHORIZED**

You can participate in-line skates with a maximum of 5 wheels, provided that the following is observed:

- length can not exceed 50 cm (wheels included);
- the diameter of the wheels is free up to a maximum of 125 mm;
- the fixing pins can not protrude from the wheels or turntables;
- the skids must be firmly secured to the shoes;

You can participate in traditional skate (4 wheels - in parallel).

You can participate in Skate Longerboard as long as you respect the following:

- maximum of 4 wheels;
- length should not exceed 160cm;
- the diameter of the wheels must not exceed 210mm.

- 04:15 pm | Last relay (15 minutes from the end of the race, the relay zone is closed and dismantled, and the change of participants will no longer be allowed)
- 04:30 pm | End of the race
- 05:00 pm | Podium ceremony
